The school is entitled to Carlo Anti, an archaeologist who lived in Villafranca in the first half of the 20th century.

There are 980 students in full time education, 144 teachers and 40 members of the technical, administrative staff.

Laboratories

The school has a number of laboratories equipped with multimedia interactive whiteboards and ADSL and HDSL Internet connections, Intranet, videoconferencing, a Physics lab, a Chemistry lab, a CAD (Computer Aided Design) lab, some graphics design and multimedia labs, a photo lab, automation and electrotechnics labs.

The school has created and manages some e-learning and CMS (Content Management System) platforms, thanks to which both teachers and students can document lessons, post the materials produced or used, administer tests and assignments online, open forums for sharing issues, etc.

It also manages a channel of video streaming for shooting events, conferences, training workshops and produces live video and offers video streaming services on demand.

Curricular activities

In addition to standard teaching, the school promotes and carries out a lot of projects:

– participation in the Olympics in chemistry, physics, mathematics, science, philosophy, Italian and in various competitions both at a national and an international level.

– Aurora Project: creation of drawings in direct connection (through the Internet) with companies, agencies and design studios in the industry as part of normal teaching.

– School-job rotation and work experiences with companies and institutions in the area.

– Virtual Training Firms.

Extra curricular activities

– theatre, band

– sports teams, driver education and moped license

– educational guidance for the fifth year students: Itinera project, individualized counseling, Tandem project in cooperation with the University of Verona

– intercultural project for foreign students
