UniTO is one of the most prestigious Italian Universities. It is open to an international perspective both in the field of research and in the field of training; with reference to the Leiden index, UniTO is 2nd in Italy. It has been involved in many international networks, such as the EU FP for Research and the following programmes: LLP, EDULINK, Tempus, ALFA, Erasmus Mundus, Erasmus Mundus External Cooperation Window. Coordinating institution of the geoNatHaz project, financed by EU-Canada Programme, from 2009 up to 2011, since 1980, UniTO has taken part in EU funded research projects as well as by other international organisations. The International Relations Office (IRO) plays a strong role in supporting visiting faculty and students by helping them for anything concerning their prospective study or research period at the UNiTO.

Each module making up the degree programmes run by the Department of Mathematics has an up-to-date webpage, which incorporates all the relevant information for students.
